Dear Parent or Guardian:

The Comstock Park Public School's Integrated Pest Management contractor EnviroSafe, Inc. and our staff have been working to eliminate a pest concern (hornets and yellow jackets) at your child's school. Given the nature and location of this pest, they felt it was warranted to apply a pesticide to try to resolve this concern.

A controlled pesticide application, using a product approved by the EPA, was applied. The application was done by technicians who are State licensed and trained in the use of pesticides. The application was deemed an emergency, and that is why notification is being given after the application. The treatment is described below:

School: Pine Island Elementary

Date of Application: July 24, 2015

Area Treated: Soccer field bleachers; soccer storage barn; main entrance tree

Description of Treatment: Cimexa dust. This was applied in areas that are not accessible to the students.
