

## **Academic Support Center Descriptions**

**All Centers Run from 2:40 – 3:40 on the Designated Days**

**Late Bus Pickup is at 4:00 PM**

***E 20/20 Re-teach/Re-test Center – B217 – Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays –***

This room will serve as the central point for any re-teaching or re-testing through E 20/20 per content area policy for math, science, English, and social studies. The environment in this room will be reflective of an environment conducive for re-learning and test taking. **Students will be assigned to this room by the appropriate content area teacher as needed.**

***Math Remediation Center – D103 – Tuesdays & Thursdays –***

This room will serve as a location for Algebra I math students. A designated teacher will provide direct instruction to help the students develop pre algebra skills. **Students will be pre assigned to this room by the appropriate teacher.**

***English Language Arts “Writing Lab” Center – Tuesdays B206 & Thursdays D107 -***

These rooms will serve as locations for any ELA student (but mostly focused on 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade) to consult with an ELA teacher on grammar issues and completing, editing, or revising writing assignments.

***Math Center – D105 – Tuesdays & Wednesdays -***

This room will serve as a location for any math student in Algebra I, Geometry, or Algebra II to come and receive assistance on classroom work/homework. This room will include a math teacher. Students should come prepared with their book, notes, and questions.

***Special Education Math Support Center – B210 – Tuesdays & Thursdays -***

This room will serve as a re-teaching location twice each week. Key concepts on lessons and key vocabulary will be re-visited and in some cases re-assessed with the opportunity to improve or replace quiz grades. For any student who misses a day of the regular class, this would be an ideal opportunity to catch up on missed content. Prior to unit tests, intensive reviews will be conducted.

***Independent Work/Tutoring Center – Media Center – Tuesdays & Thursdays –***

This room will serve as location for students to work on school work independently or with an assigned tutor. Students should come prepared with any needed materials. Athletes may use this room to serve eligibility time. Athletes will not have their sheet signed if they do not use the time to work and if they do not stay the full hour.
