Moderate Aggression:Physical Contact:pushing, shoving, grabbing, tripping etc.Intimidation:Threats of emotional or physical aggression,planned exclusion, etc.Disrespect of personal property:Disrespect to personal property of others	* Behavior Referral w/documentation * Plan of Action written with parent signature required * Review Expectations	 * Behavior Referral w/documentation * Loss of Recess (1 to 3 days) * Student to write note to parent notifying loss of recess privileges and reason * Review previous Action Plan 	* Behavior Referral w/documentation * Loss of Lunch and recess * Loss of recess 5 to 10 days * Complete written Bully lesson
More Severe Aggression: Physical Contact: Hitting,/punching, kicking, fighting and similar behavior that risks injury to other, etc. Intimidation: Stalking, severe threats of emotional or physical violence, harassment, repeated intimidation, etc. Disrespect of personal property: Theft or damage of personal property of others with the intent to show disrespect or intimidation	* Behavior Referral w/documentation * In School Suspension for the remainder of the day * Loss of lunch and recess for 3-5 days * Complete written Bully Lesson * Parent notification by staff * Optional Parent/Administrator conference	 * Behavior Referral w/documentation * Suspension - 1 to 3 days; (in-school or out of school to be determined by school) * Loss Lunch/Recess privileges up to 30 days * Review previous Action Plan * Administrator call to parent * Parent/Administrator meeting required upon student returning to school * Behavioral Intervention Plan per Administrator discretion 	* Behavior Referral w/documentation * Indefinite out-of school suspension * Loss Lunch/Recess privileges to be determined upon return * Administrator call to parent * Parent/Administrator meeting required upon student returning to school * Behavioral Intervention Plan per Administrator discretion

* All 4th plus offenses result in an individual plan and notification to principal. Also may result in referral for expulsion.

* Optional parent/guardian phone call may be included at any step.

* Consequences are subject to change at the discretion of the administration for all offenses
