



## Is it a Cold or the Flu?

| <b>Symptoms</b>           | Cold  | Flu  |
|---------------------------|---|--|
| Fever                     | Uncommon  | Common; a temperature of 100° or higher for 3 to 4 days is associated with the flu |
| Headache                  | Uncommon  | Very common; sudden onset  |
| General aches, pains      | Mild  | Common; often severe   |
| Fatigue, weakness         | Mild  | Often extreme; can last 2 to 3 weeks   |
| <b>Extreme Exhaustion</b> | Never   | Very common at first; sudden onset   |
| Stuffy nose               | Common  | Sometimes  |
| Sneezing                  | Common  | Sometimes  |
| Sore throat               | Common  | Sometimes  |
| Chest discomfort, cough   | Mild to moderate, hacking cough   | Common; can become severe  |
| Complications             | Sinus congestion, earache, asthma   | Bronchitis, pneumonia; can be life threatening                                     |
| Prevention                | Wash your hands; cover<br>your cough; avoid close<br>contact with anyone with a<br>cold | Annual vaccination; wash your hands; cover your cough                              |
| Treatment                 | Over-the-counter medication for temporary   | See your doctor  |
